The purpose of this publication is to commemorate and acknowledge the service, courage, sacrifice and commitment of Australian service personnel from Federation to the present day. It is intended as an educational and historical resource, highlighting significant events, campaigns and places connected to Australia's involvement in conflicts and peacekeeping operations.

This publication is not intended to be a complete or definitive record of all Australian military history. Rather, it provides a geographic overview of significant and meaningful contributions, recognising the experiences of those who served and the impact of their actions on Australia and the wider world.

Special consideration has been given to earlier conflicts, including the Sudan and South African campaigns, due to historical chronology and the inclusion of names from these conflicts within official Australian commemorative records.

The creation of this map was made possible through research and reference materials from a range of historical sources, including publications and resources produced by the Australian War Memorial, Canberra, and other recognised historical institutions.
